How To Choose The Best Photographer So You Will Be Thrilled With Your Portraits.

Your family is very important to you and organising everyone to have a family portrait is no mean feat especially when you are trying to organise several generations (you, your children and your grandchildren). There are so many different personalities and ages to coordinate.

This can't be done on your own and a photographer who values the importance of your family just as much as you do is who you need to help you achieve the portraits of your dreams.

Before making a decision on who will photograph your family, it is important to meet each photographer you are considering, face-to-face. By doing this, you will instantly know if you feel comfortable with him/her. You will be under no obligation to use that photographer if they don't fit your requirements but make sure you meet them first.

This is what to look for in a photographer...

Do They Offer A 100% Money Back Guarantee?

By choosing a photographer who offers a 100% money back guarantee, instantly tells you they understand how important your family is to you. Offering a 100% money back guarantee says they will do whatever it takes to make sure you are absolutely thrilled with your portraits.

Do They Have Experience & Skills To Photograph A Large Family Portrait?

You also want to feel confident that your photographer will exceed your expectations so you want to see that they have the experience and skills required to achieve this. When you meet the photographer, you should be reassured that they can work comfortably and confidently with young children, babies, teenagers and adults (collectively) and work quickly setting up poses while making it a fun and great time for everyone involved.

Do They Have A Folio Of Large Family Portraits To Show You?

It takes a special kind of photographer to photograph big families well and the right photographer will have a port folio of their own work to show you. Before you commit to a booking, make sure you view their folio and confirm that *they* took the photographs they are showing you (because sometimes portrait studios have multiple photographers and another photographer could have taken the photographs they are showing you). If they can't show you any samples of large family groups, they obviously don't specialise in this field and may not be able to deliver the quality portraits you are hoping for

Do They Offer A Planning Session?

If everything is looking promising so far, then you need to make sure the photographer offers a planning session (at least two weeks before your portrait session) to plan and coordinate all aspects of your portrait session. This will separate a good photographer from a bad one because this planning session allows the photographer to completely understand *you* on a personal level. They are genuinely interested in you and what your family is about and will portray that in your photographs. This is so valuable because it shows they care about you and committed to creating something special. A photographer who doesn't offer a planning session will only be guessing what you want and will do what they do with every other family - create an average portrait.

Do They Photograph On Location?

Choosing a photographer who photographs on location will make your portraits more meaningful to you. It not only means that you can choose a location that has personal significance but your whole family will enjoy your time there because they are in familiar surroundings. This could be your own home, a park you frequent or even the beach. You should expect the photographer to travel to a location that you would love to have your portraits taken otherwise you may want to consider another photographer *unless* he/she has good reason to not use that location. If you have chosen a location the photographer has not been to, they will check that location out soon after the planning session to make sure it is suitable for family portraits. If it has too many distractions or it doesn't fit the style of portraits you hope to hang on the wall, the photographer may suggest other locations that are more suitable. The most important thing here, is that the photographer *will* photograph on location in a place that you and your family will love and enjoy.

Do They Print, Frame and Hang Your Portraits?

Your priority in having your family portrait is to have beautiful portraits of your family hanging proudly in your home. It is a preservation of *your* history and it is important that the finished work looks amazing. Your photographer should print, frame and hang the portraits for you because they know exactly what to do. They will use quality, professional services so the colour, clarity and finish of your work will look amazing (and you won't get a finish like this if you were to print the photographs yourself).

One thing to consider... You have to look at these portraits for the rest of your life so you want them to be preserved for decades and enjoyed for generations. If you are given a USB with photos, the chances of you getting around to printing them are slim or if you do get around to printing, framing and hanging them yourself, the quality will not be as good as if your photographer printed them for you. You will be so thrilled you did.

If the photographer you are considering ticks all the right boxes, you will have found the perfect photographer to capture your dream portraits.

What Is A 'Photography Agreement'?

You have chosen a photographer that you are excited about. You feel comfortable with him/her, they offer a guarantee, you love the work they have shown you, they are skilled in photographing large families, they will help you prepare for your portrait session and photograph at a location you love...Now to get the formalities out of the way.

Each photographer has a different system upon booking a portrait session but one thing they have in common is the 'photography agreement'. This is an important document because it clarifies everything you have discussed with your photographer and agreed upon, with no misunderstandings.

Always read the fine print of a photography agreement and if you are unsure about anything or need further clarification, always ask before signing.

Why Is A Planning Session (Or Design Consultation) So Important?

You are so excited, your photographer is sorted and your portrait session date is booked.

Now you have to get the family organised and you find that takes more effort than you thought...in fact, it is quite challenging!

This is where your photographer becomes your best friend. They will take you by the hand and guide you through every step in creating the most beautiful portraits you will ever have, and the planning session is where it all begins.

When you confirmed your booking, your photographer only had a small understanding of who you are and it is very important they get to know you on a more personal level.

They want to know who you are and what your family is all about. By meeting you in your home, at least two weeks before your portrait session, they will gain a great understanding of you and what you want to achieve.

It is best to arrange the planning session at least two weeks before the portraits session because this allows you plenty of time to get things organised without leaving it to the last minute, giving you plenty of time to prepare.

If possible, involve as many family members as you can in the planning session because the more involved they are, the more comfortable they will feel about having their photographs taken and the happier they will be with the results.

By coming to your home, your photographer will see how you intend to display your portraits. They will look at the colours of your home, how the room is decorated and they may offer you suggestions. From

there, the style of your portrait is discussed, a location is chosen and clothes are coordinated, blending all elements together to create a unified portrait that will hang beautifully in your home.

What you all wear in the portrait is so important. *I can't stress that enough!* If your family members can't be at the planning session, then the photographer will start by assisting you and your husband with what to wear and asks that the rest of the family coordinates to you. A good photographer will give you tips to pass onto the family so they can work out their outfits. It's important to coordinate with each other while still keeping your own individual styles - this can be tricky so the photographer should be the main go-to person and may ask each family group (within your family) to take a photo of what they plan to wear so the photographer can oversee the outfits and make adjustments accordingly (if required). This is generally done via text or email. By having everyone happily involved, they will also understand how important this is to you and will feel important themselves.

Everything You Have Been Planning For Is Now Here - Your Portrait Session.

The day has finally arrived! All the planning and preparation you have put into creating your once-in-a-life-time portrait all comes together.

The day of your portrait session should be enjoyable because everything will have been planned before this day. How proud are you? Everyone looks great. You are all laughing and enjoying each other. The sniggers and jokes being said about being so physically close to each other are hilarious!
